Open Forum. There were no public comments during open Forum.

- 1. January minutes: Motion to approve Craig Lindholm, seconded by Rodney Kieke and approved unanimously.
- <u>2. Monthly Financials</u>: After discussion it was agreed that the finance committee will review past practices and provide a format for review.
- 3. Lake Fork Chamber Boat Shows: Approved to pay out of the Advertising and Legal notices budget line item.
- 4. Fishing University Program: Discussion of the TV channels and audience the program will reach. Millions in the audience and will be broadcasted 120 times across the country. Motion to fund \$1,625 was made by Craig Lindholm and seconded by Vic Savelli. Motion passed.
- <u>5. June 2020 Bass Masters Texas Fest</u>: The committee represented by the SRA, the Quitman Chamber of Commerce, and WCEDC is making good progress. WCEDC members would like an email showing the details.
- <u>6. Search Committee for Executive Director</u>: Jim Berry and Greg Hollen provided details of the search and progress to date. It is anticipated that we will be interviewing within 30 days.
- 7. Meeting Location and Time: Discussion regarding meeting location and attendees prompted a desire to explore additional options of a new location and time.
- **8. By Laws:** The current by laws appear to be in conflict with the statute. A new set of by laws were passed out and will be reviewed for the next meeting. We will need to rescind the current by laws and adopt a new set that is in compliance with the statute.
- **9. Chairman's Report:** Tom Keenan presented a synopsis of the Strategic Plan and proposed committee structures from which to measure the WCEDC's efforts to improve the quality of life in Wood County.

<u>Interim Executive Director's Report</u>: Jim Berry presented details on the strength and professionalism of the individual members of the WCEDC. He feels confident that Judge Hebron has assembled a committee that will achieve success in improving the quality of life for residents of Wood County.
